


# University of South Carolina Aphasia Lab Parking/Directions

Thank you for your interest in participating in our research. Our address is **915 Greene Street, Columbia, SC 29208**. The name of the building is the Discovery Building and it is located directly across the street from the Colonial Life Arena at the corner of Lincoln and Greene streets (see map below).



Please park in the Discovery Parking Garage located at **821 Park Street, Columbia, SC**. This is located next to the Discovery building (see map). Use the Park Street entrance.

- You may park in one of the reserved spaces marked **Research Study Participants – Arnold School of Public Health** located on the entry level of the garage (after entering garage, drive straight back to the elevator and turn right).
- Be sure to bring your parking garage ticket in with you so that we can validate it for you during your appointment.
- Take the elevator to the first floor and turn right. You will be facing the Discovery Building.
- Enter the building through the front doors (facing the Colonial Life Arena) and take the elevator to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.
- After exiting the elevator turn LEFT to follow the signs to the Communication Sciences and Disorders (COMD) waiting room (Room 255).
- Ring the doorbell to our offices to let us know that you are here.
